Purpose of Community Involvement Committee

- To provide the members of PWC with quarterly opportunities to give back to the community as well as raise community awareness of PWC. Service can be defined as:
 - 1) active service (fellowship)
 - 2) passive service (donation of items)
 - 3) a combination of time and service

Components of a "perfect" service project would include ...

- an opportunity for PWC members to volunteer a 2-4 hour block of their time.
- a specific start and end time.
- an organization and project that have an unique or significant need for volunteers.
- results that benefit females (directly or indirectly).
- an apolitical agenda and not affiliated with a specific religion.
- no solicitation of money.
- results that deepen PWC member connection to each other and people in need.
